Courses: Classic European Cyclocross courses... most with a paved start/finish, rolling grass hills, technical climbing and descending, natural run-ups, and sand with double pit zones.

Race Information:

- Price is \$45 per race for adults, \$30 for Junior racers (racing age 18 & under)
- This price is the online pre-registration price. Pre-registration closes Thursdays before each race at 6pm.
- Add \$10 for on-site registration.
- All racers must sign-in at registration and fill out USA Cycling standard release form.
- Registration opens at 12pm on each race day, and closes 10 minutes before start.
- Race entry fee is \$0 for racers with a current USAC cyclocross ranking under 300 points*.

A USAC license is required to race this event. Anyone racing in a USAC Cat that includes a level 5 license may purchase a one day license on site. All other categories require an annual USAC license. Registration price includes the USAC insurance fee. Racing age calculated as of 12/31/2024.
